The process of charging a rechargeable SCS can vary depending on the device and individual needs and preferences. ad When a SCS device's battery is running low, it will be a warning that a charge is needed quickly. The charging process usually includes: Spinal Cord Stimulation for Chronic Back Pain Video Taking the fully charged charger (from a base station) and placing it over the skin where the implanted SCS device is located. Many systems include a belt to easily hold the charger where it needs to be. Aligning the charger's internal antenna so that it can maximize the signal strength of the charger on the SCS device. Factors that may affect how often a SCS needs to be charged are: Battery size. Some devices are equipped with a larger (or more efficient) battery and can of course last longer before charging. Over time, the device's battery needs to be charged more frequently because it functions less efficiently with age. Therapy settings. The SCS can be programmed in different ways, depending on the nature of the pain and therapy needs. For example, if multiple programs run on the device at the same time, the battery drains Similarly, if the therapy settings send longer (rather than shorter) pulses, more energy is used. Stimulator use. Severe pain may require more frequent device use, causing the device's battery to run out faster compared to devices that are only used sparingly. Type of electrode. A padded electrode tends to use less energy than a percutaneous lead. Device location. The area of the spine that needs stimulation can affect how much energy is used. For example, more energy is spent by stimulating the lumbar spine than the cervical spine. A rechargeable SCS used for the neck is likely to last longer before it needs to be charged. User preference. Some users prefer shorter charging times and are willing to charge their device more often. For example, if a full top-up of a low battery lasts about 8 hours a week, some patients prefer a 2-hour charge every other day.
